BORS Presidential Responsibilities

- The President is the figurehead and leader of the BORS. They are responsible for setting goals and objectives, managing the Exec team and overseeing all corresponding activity.
- As President, you are responsible for leading the BORS and coordinating all activity. You do this through the exec, which should be inspired and motivated.
- Provide support, advice and guidance to your exec and members throughout the year.
- Maintain close communication and support the BORS administrator.
- Respond to the trustees where appropriate.
- Attend trustees meetings.
- Plan on ways for BORS to grow.
- Organise exec meetings with the help of the BORS administrator.
- Oversee the annual meeting with help from the exec.
- Organise and oversee the AGM with help from the exec .
- Maintain the membership of the exec be aware of the termination dates of the other exec members.
- Attend and participate in ICORS meetings the meetings usually take place at the ORS
- Help and participate in the selection of BORS Travelling Fellowship.
- Help organise the program for the travelling fellowship.
- Advise the secretary where appropriate.
- Advise the treasure where appropriate.
- If required provide information to the media on musculoskeletal issues.
- Sit on the BOA specialist society committee.
- Communicate with other societies within the musculoskeletal area.
